Rules & Regulations

Thank you for being a part of our dance community.

As the time comes nearer for us to get back into the dance studio, we have put a few new rules into place to keep our kids and families as safe as we can.

Entering The Building

All masked dancers will remain outside until dancers are called upon to enter through our main front door. Dancers 5 and up should be okay to enter the building by themselves. Our younger dancers can be escorted in by one masked family member, but parents will need to exit after the class has started.

At the time of entrance, all masked dancers will have their temperature taken, along with a pump of hand sanitizer and given instructions to enter the building. Anyone with a temperature higher than 100.4 will be sent home.

Dancers will be instructed on where to place their belongings (shoes, extra mask, water bottle in a small bag)

Entering The Dance Studios

Once belongings have been placed in their assigned area, masked dancers can enter their respective studio. Each dancer will find a numbered 6 ft box taped out on the floor. They are to use that specific 6 foot box for the rest of class. If the weather permits, windows in the studios will be open. We have also installed HEPPA filters in the heat/air conditioning units.

Exiting The Building

All Dancers will be guided to the side doors to exit the building, one at a time. Hand Sanitizing will also happen directly after class & while leaving the studio/building. Dancers should safely wait on the lawn to be picked up. Please make sure to be prompt when picking up your dancers. Our staff will need to be available to assist the next class that will be arriving for class. All classes have been staggered so that there is only one group of dancers moving in one direction in the back hallway. Absolutely no playing in the parking lots.

Personal Belongings & Personal Responsibility

All dancers should bring in their own labeled water bottle. All dancers should bring in their own mini hand sanitizer to use throughout the time in class. No large dance bags. We don't want any unnecessary items in the building.

Leave cell phones at home if possible.

Street shoes and dance bags will remain in their designated area, so as to not clutter the dance studios.

Off Limits

The lobby will be closed to family members. We are only allowed so many bodies in the building at any given time and that will be reserved for students and staff.

The Locker Room will no longer be used as a hangout, but rather a storage area (distanced) for dance bags, shoes, etc.

No beverages will be available for purchase.

Doors will be closed to studios that are being unused.

Browsing in the store is off limits, please ask a staffer for assistance.

Suggestions

Use the bathroom prior to entering the building. Only use the bathroom in case of emergency. Do as much interaction via email or phone when it comes to registration, questions, payments.

If there is a temp, DO NOT COME!

Mandatory

ANYONE entering the building, MUST wear a mask.

Thoroughly wash hands before and after class (at home) on top of sanitizing at the studio. Do NOT come if you are feeling ill. Children will be sent home if staff deems it appropriate. Continue to communicate with your child the importance of Distancing, Hand Washing, etc. Dance teachers will maintain social distance from kids and speak only when safely distant. Dancers should never wear the same dance shoes in the class, as they were wearing outside.

Do Not come if you or family members have been exposed to anyone COVID-positive. Notify the studio immediately if you, your dancer or family member has been tested positive. 14 days must pass before returning to studio if you, your dancer, or family member is positive and a negative must be submitted or emailed to the front desk. We are a tech enabled studio and any dancer that is out of class will have the option to sign into their class via ZOOM.

Staff Responsibilities

We will be cleaning in between classes by wiping down high traffic areas and surfaces. It is encouraged that people DO NOT touch anything they don't need to.

Spraying floors throughout the afternoon and evening.

Wiping down barres in between classes.

Wiping down door knobs, front desk area, bathrooms, etc..

Thank you for your patience and help in navigating on how to continue to make our studio as safe as we can and a fun environment for all of our students. While none of this is ideal, it is our new reality in order to get our kids back into our studio doors.
